Achillea millefolium `Royal Tapestry', AKA Yarrow = royal-purple with white eyes, 24-26", June-September. A selection by Roy Klehm with rich color. Attracts butterflies. Loves Sun, tolerates any kind of soil. Drought resistant. OK in Hardiness zones 4 - 9 (we are 7b here in Philadelphia - see www.plants.usda.gov for more)

Artemisia - stelleriana 'Silver Brocade', PPAF 4-10", white haired, silver leaves are lobed and slightly toothed. This form is more ground hugging with a central woodylight base. Looks very wooly-like resembling the look of the annual. Native to NE Asia & E US. Zone 3 AKA "Hardly Dusty Miller" "Old Woman" "Beach Wormwood" Drought resistant - likes moist soil and sun.

Ajuga Linda Applegate = Brightly basal toned-lush green slightly scalloped leaf, vigorous ground-cover topped with showy spires of white flowers. 6-8" tall in bloom, April-May. PPA 2007 - OK with clay soil, prefers moist part shade/sun or shade tolerant.

Astilbe 'Cattleya' (arendsii), not too dark pink flowers in large full plumes, nice tall at about 36", July-August later bloomer, a favorite for stature. prefers moist part shade/sun or shade tolerant.

Caropteris incana `Sunshine Blue', vivid amethyst blue flowers, 36" blooms September-October. The sunshine for this one comes in the leaves. Rich yellow foliage makes this a standout in the garden. The incana forms have wider leaves giving a much fuller look. The flowers are also more pronounced as they are held in thick bundles along the stems. Butterfly aircraft carrier. This is one large perennial so use it in place of a shrub. Likes sun, average to dry soils. zones 5-9. Native US plant. Nicely scented leaves when crushed between your fingers.

Echinacea purpurea 'Magnus', deep rose flowers are larger than normal and the petals don't seem to droop. 36" tall. Blooms June-August. Nice as a Cut flower. Perennial Plant Association Plant of the Year 1984-9. Drought resistant, dry or moist sun conditions. Native to US.

Hardy Geranium x 'Johnson's Blue', vivid violet blue flowers, 18-24" tall, blooms from June to August. Long bloom time and a large perfect mound of color. Drought resistant, moist or dry sun or part/sun/shade planting location.

GRASS - s. 'Morning Light', silvery white variegated leaves. Short form but it is still 3-4' feet tall. "Silver Maiden Grass" - Drought resistant, clay soil tolerant, and loves either dry or moist sun locations. 1 gallon pot.

HARDY LOBELIA x(cardinalis x siphilitica x fulgens)mixed color range of purple,pink,red,fuchsia,hot,pink s,scarlet,lavender,blue,20-36",June-August. All colors are bright, vibrant and electric.Huge flower stalks up to 2' long and branched-great cutting flower with 2 week vase life. AKA "Cardinal Flower"(no "Cardinal Sin"being comitted here!)A fabulous cross-pollination result from Benary's. Zone 3.This flowers great in lots of sun but keep its feet moist.Part-shade and average moisture keeps it going.Lots of shade then I would keep it well drained and some good water in between. Keep it from settling during the winter or it may succumb to crown "rot".Lots of sun and no water will bring on the "bugs".

Potentilla -Scarlett Starlet - atrosanguinea var. argyrophylla. Bright scarlet-red, 15-17', June-July. Silkey, hairy leaves, three-parted, toothed. Basal leaves are evergreen. Saucer shaped flowers. Sun, well drained soils. zones 5-8 (Looks like a strawberry plant with red flowers on steroids to me)

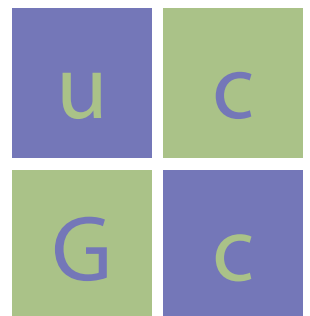
