Commitment to the full training schedule (below) is a must:

- Professional development sessions at WPSI in West Philadelphia: Mon Fri, 9 A.M. 12 P.M from Aug 12 Aug 30 The office is a 2-minute walk from the 40<sup>th</sup> St. Stop on the Market-Frankford line and accessible by bus routes 21,30, and 40.
- Technical Training at the Grant Blvd studio in Kensington: Mon Weds, 10 A.M. 3 P.M. from Sep 3 Oct 17
- Externship at the Grant Blvd studio in Kensington: Mon Weds, 10 A.M. 5 P.M. from Oct 21 Nov 14 The studio is a 6-minute walk from the Tioga stop on the Market-Frankford line and accessible by bus routes 3, 56, and 89.

This is a hybrid in-person and virtual program. Consistent access to a laptop or desktop computer, broadband internet, a webcam, and a word processing program like Microsoft Word, Google Docs, or similar are required to complete the training.
