Program Details

The West Philadelphia Skills Initiative (WPSI) created this program with Community College of Philadelphia to provide you with the certification and workplace skills to build a career in health care. Program completion requires in-person attendance at several locations, consistent online participation and passing all certification requirements.

This program offers you:

- Cutting-edge job connection strategies, resulting in 93% of graduates finding employment
- A \$150 weekly stipend while in training
- Free Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) training and testing
- The opportunity to interview for open Patient Care Technician positions, starting at \$20/ hour, across all shifts, including overnight with a pay differential, at Penn Medicine

Who Should Apply? This program is for:

- Strong written and verbal communicators who are comfortable managing their own time and working with patients in a clinical context
- Individuals who can commit to overnight shifts
- Those able to commit to the full training schedule:
 - Professional development sessions, Mondays, Sept. 9– Nov. 4, 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
 - Certified Nursing Assistant Training, Tuesdays to Thursdays, Sept. 10–26, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
 - Certified Nursing Assistant Training Clinicals, Tuesdays to Thursdays, Oct. 1–15, 6:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - One self-scheduled 30-minute Career Coaching session per month via Zoom
 - This program requires assignments, studying, and meetings online, so consistent access to a laptop or desktop computer, broadband internet, a webcam, and a word processing program like Microsoft Word, Google Docs, or similar are required to complete the training.

Program Eligibility

- All applicants must be a resident of Philadelphia, be tobacco free, commit to the full training schedule, possess a high school diploma or GED and be currently unemployed or underemployed.
- Candidates for the Patient Care Technician Program must provide proof of having received the full COVID-19 vaccine by Tuesday, July 30, 2024, to be considered.
